A RESOLUTION

1 Designating Russian Cosmonaut Sergey K. Krikalev from the
2 Commonwealth of Independent States as a "Hero of Mars,
3 Pennsylvania."

4 WHEREAS, Cosmonaut Sergey K. Krikalev has spent more than 432
5 days in space with ten months of continuous weightlessness
6 aboard the space station Mir; and

7 WHEREAS, Cosmonaut Sergey K. Krikalev is an agent of world
8 peace through his ten-day goodwill "Mission to Mars,"
9 Pennsylvania, with United States Astronaut Navy Lieutenant
10 Commander Mario Runco, Jr. during the month of September 1989;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Cosmonaut Sergey K. Krikalev's gentle demeanor and
13 genuine interest in the children of Mars, Pennsylvania,
14 demonstrated the common ties of humanity which bind all human
15 beings; and

16 WHEREAS, Cosmonaut Sergey K. Krikalev is a "Hero of the
17 Commonwealth of Independent States" for his service to

1 humankind, both in space and on earth; therefore be it
2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
3 Cosmonaut Sergey K. Kirkalev a "Hero of Mars, Pennsylvania."
